Introduction and Background

The Tower Renewal program seeks an integrated approach to achieve improvements to Toronto's more than 1,000 vintage apartment buildings and their neighborhoods. The range of program initiatives includes building retrofits, community programming and enhanced employment opportunities. The work required to achieve the improvements will create demand for products and services. By facilitating the local provision of these products and services, economic development benefits will be maximized in local communities.

To help maximize local benefits, and as an initial step, the City of Toronto has prepared this directory of Toronto area firms that provides summary information on local service and product providers. This directory will provide a foundation of information that can be used when designing and undertaking renewal projects.

Methodology

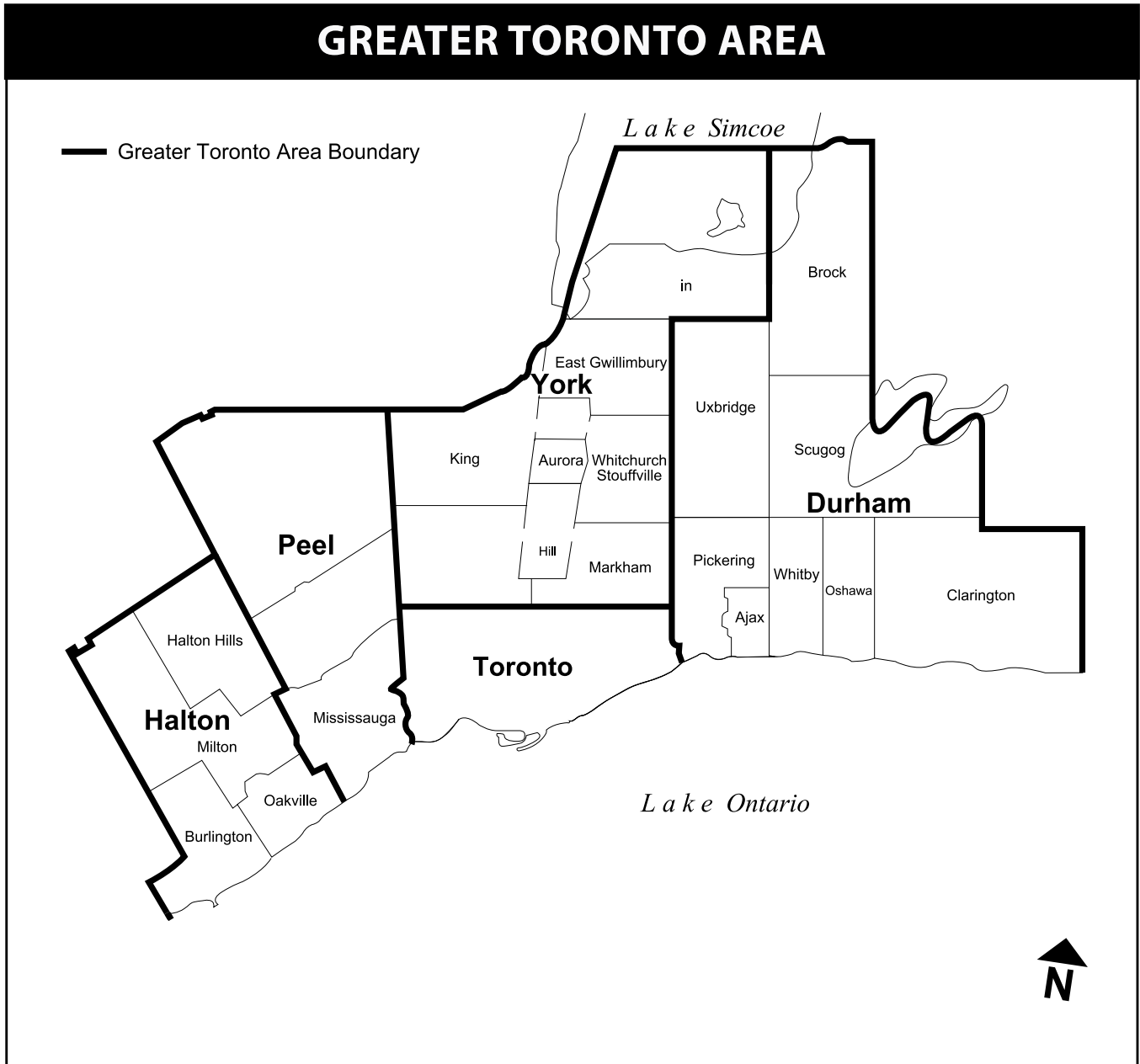
The companies included in this directory are located within the Greater Toronto Area (GTA). The rationale for including companies located outside the boundaries of the the city of Toronto is to capture the travel patterns that Toronto residents might cover for employment and other purposes. The geographic parameters of the GTA better capture these travel patterns and reflect a more cohesive group of green businesses operating in and serving the areas where Toronto residents live and interact. The area covered is outlined in the map on the next page.

This directory builds on previous research conducted by the City of Toronto in May 2010, when an initial survey of green businesses was undertaken. The survey was based on companies registered with North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes related to the green business categories listed in the table of contents. Various industry experts were also solicited for suggestions regarding green businesses that might be included in this directory.

The information on the suppliers in the directory was compiled from a review of the suppliers' respective websites and relevant product information.

The directory is a list of local suppliers that can provide products and services for green retrofits, tower renewal and new construction. By supporting these local businesses we keep jobs within the City of Toronto and the GTA.

The intent is to update and publish this directory on a regular basis. We recognize that there might be other companies that have not been captured here.
